# Installation instruction for Windows

- 1. First, unzip panasonic\_audio\_player\_2\_win\_1\_0\_0\_1Technics.zip that is the distributed as a compressed archive file.
- Double click the Setup\_PanasonicAudioPlayer2.exe file in the folder that opened in step 1 to open the installation wizard. If a software use confirmation pop-up dialog opens, click [Run] or [Yes] to continue with installation of the file.
- 3. Select the language and click [OK].

- 2. Double click the SetupPanasonicAudioPlayer2.pkg file in the folder that opened in step 1 to open the installation wizard.

If a software use confirmation pop-up dialog opens, click [Run] or [Yes] to continue with installation of the file.

- The corresponding sampling frequency and the number of quantization bits of the music files to play are limited to the specifications of the product to which you want to connect. Please read the product shipped with the instruction manual for connection details.
- For a Mac PC, if the Gatekeeper setting is anything other than "Allow applications download from anywhere", warning message will display. In this case, click [OK] to close the warning message. And control-click the file and choose [Open] from the menu. When the warning message displays, click the [Open] button.
